Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The Catholic Church of England and Wales has recommended suspending services and Masses with a congregation from last Friday evening until further notice.

The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days does not now apply. Funerals and Baptism will not be able to take place in church. Funerals will be at the graveside only.

For the moment, the church will remain open during the day for people to find solace in prayer. However, the Diocese has advised us that we will follow Government advice on social distancing, this is really important so everyone is kept safe. Please be aware this advice may also change as well. For now, if you come to pray in church, please observe the social distancing advice of being 2m apart. You need to use the hand sanitiser on entering and leaving the church. It has been advised that anyone in a vulnerable group should avoid social contact.

Happy Mothering Sunday : Today in our Country, we celebrate Mother's Day. During this difficult period for our community and country, we wish all Mothers and Grandmothers the health and the resilience to keep themselves and families safe from the effects of the current Pandemic.
